This is done by offering monetary grants to help eligible children and young adults with PANS/PANDAS receive proper diagnosis and treatment. JBC is dedicated to offering relief to PANS/PANDAS families from the emotionally and financially devastating, life-altering impacts of a PANS & PANDAS diagnosis. At least 1 in 200 children are suffering from PANS & PANDAS. An estimated 1-2% of the US Pediatric population is affected by PANS/PANDAS with an estimated 16,751-33,000 children affected by PANS & PANDAS in Massachusetts alone.
